CANDIDATE OVERVIEW:

The successful candidate will be between 17 - 30 years of age and have great availability during the months of July - August. Position will be for either 280 or 560 total hours between May-August 2021. If funding is granted for 280 hours, the bulk of those hours will be in July and August. You will have 1 full week off during the summer. Candidates must be a professed Christian and in full agreement with our Statement of Faith.

Falconridge Family Church Program Co-ordinator - Education: \$16/hour

Sunday Programming for Children: Schedule, communicate and equip volunteers who will be delivering weekly programming for children. Make any necessary adjustments to the different curriculums for May/June. Choose or write curriculums for each age level for the months of July/August. Source all needed resources and supplies. Lead during July & August.

Direct Biblical Day Camp For Children: Create 2 week-long, half-day, summer day camps for children. Recruit volunteers. Source all needed resources and supplies. Lead large group sessions as needed.

Registrar - Day Camps: In partnership with our community partner, be the registrar of the multiple day camps occurring at the facility throughout the summer.

Preteen/ Youth Programming: Schedule, communicate and equip volunteers. Make any necessary adjustments to different curriculums for May/June. Choose or write curriculums for each age level for the months of July/August. Source all needed resources and supplies.

Visual Communication & Livestream Coordinator: Write, film and edit short video commercials to begin the livestream each Sunday. Schedule and coordinate the volunteer camera operators for the livestream, training if necessary. Work with the livestream team to create the best experience for our virtual attendees.

Assistant Director Biblical Day Camps for Children: Assist the Director in creating 2 week-long, half-day, summer day camps for children. Train volunteers to lead and assist in Games, Crafts, Activities, Snack and Music. Lead a specific Station. Lead large group sessions as needed. Assist in the supervision of volunteers.

Community Liaison - Day Camps: In partnership with our community partner, be the community liaison of the multiple day camps occurring at the facility throughout the summer.
