FAMILY WORSHIP AT HOME

Here is how to create your Family Worship experience at home this week.

CORE BIBLE LESSON:

You will need to gather the following supplies:

- "God's People" and "Philistine" signs that were included with this packet
- heavy Bible - or a heavy book to pretend is a Bible
- 2 bags - shopping bags work great!
- 7 shoes
- 1 tissue
- large blanket - the heavier the better
- soft ball or stuffed animal

Tape the "God's People" sign to 1 bag and the "Philistines" to the other bag.

CRAFT - Pompom Slingshots

Supplies

- cardstock (½ piece)
- uninflated balloon
- small pom poms
- scissors - from home
- tape - from home
- markers - from home
- optional - decorating supplies, such as stickers, ribbon, and Glue Dots



Make Slingshots

- Roll up the cardstock to make a tube.
- Without inflating the balloon, tie off the end as if it's inflated.
- Cut off the top half of the balloon and throw it away. (Watch younger kids carefully to make sure they don't put balloons in their mouths.)
- Stretch the bottom half of the balloon (the part with the knot) around the paper tube, make it as tight as possible.
- Tape the balloon in place.
- Decorate the balloon with markers, stickers, ribbon, or other decorating supplies. Make sure nothing covers the open end.

Use Slingshots

To launch, kids will place one pompom in the tube, pull the balloon by the knot, and let go. Have kids try to hit specific marks on the wall, such as the corner of two bricks. Or if you're brave, you can be the target! Kids can also experiment with launching more than one pompom at a time.

Talk About It

Ask: • **Why would David use a slingshot to fight a giant?**

- **What did that show you about God's power?**
- **Why is God more powerful than any weapon?**

Say: **David could've used a more powerful weapon than a slingshot. He could've worn the body armor King Saul offered him. Goliath had a sword, javelin, and a spear. But none of that mattered. David had the best weapon of all: God was on his side. God is on our side as we face life's battles.**
